

Prof. Khamisi Hamidi (Ph.D.) Curriculum Vitae

He was born in the state of Batna in Algeria. He is specialized in literature and human sciences. He obtained a bachelor's degree in methodology from the University of Algiers in 1976. He also obtained a diploma in advanced studies from the University of Damascus in 1980, and a master's degree from the same university in 1983 with a very good grade. University of Algiers in 1999 with the first honors degree on the topic (Unity of Existence between Literature, Philosophy and Sufism) and held several scientific and administrative positions at the University of Algiers, including Vice-President of the University for Scientific Research and Postgraduate Studies and Chairman of the Scientific Council of the University, then President of the University of Algiers from 2013 to 2017, then he was elected Secretary-General First assistant to the Association of Arab Universities at the end of 2017. He worked as general director of the Annals of the University of Algeria, a research magazine, director of publication for the Algerian Journal of Legal Sciences, and director of the Sufi Discourse Journal. He was elected director of the Sufi Discourse Laboratory in Language and Literature, and supervised several research projects with the European Group in Within the framework of the tempus program and the Erasmus + program, he supervised a group of research teams at the University of Algiers, twenty master's theses, and ten doctoral dissertations. He is the author of five books on literature and humanities, and more than twenty published articles on literature, philosophy and mysticism. He wrote an extensive introduction to the encyclopedia (Tlemcen, Capital of Islamic Culture) with a book within the encyclopedia "Abu Madin Shuaib al-Tilmisani", supervised and co-authored a joint book with a research team of Algerian researchers and the American Binghamton University in New York under the supervision of Professor Ricardo De Larmon on Sufi orders in North Africa. This book was published and translated into English. He was interested in research projects on the unity of sciences. He gave the first inaugural lecture for university admission in 2005 on Sufism and modern physics in the presence of the then President of the Republic. And scientific research in Algeria to where?. He also presented and participated in several international conferences, the most recent of which was the conference of the Association of Islamic Universities with an intervention on the topic "global development in terms of standards and local in terms of subject matter."
